C. G. Fuller Foundation Scholarship

- *Applicant must be a South Carolina resident
- *Applicant must attend a South Carolina college or university
- *Applicant must be a high school senior entering their first year of college
- *SAT score must meet or exceed 1100 (reading & math) or ACT composite score must meet or exceed 24
- *Adjusted Gross Income of parent(s) or guardian(s) from IRS Form 1040 or 1040A must be \$60,000 or less. A complete copy (all pages) of most current tax return must accompany the application.
- *Deadline for submitting application is post marked by April 1
- *Applicant may be contacted for an in-person interview
- *Board of Trustees meets in June or July. Applicants are notified by mail regarding decision.
- *Recipients are awarded \$1,250.00 per semester for 8 semesters as long as their GPA is 3.0 or higher. Recipients must submit proof of GPA to the Foundation at the end of each semester. If GPA falls below 3.0, the recipient is placed on probation for one semester. If no improvement is made during the probation period, the scholarship is cancelled.

C. G. Fuller Foundation

Mr. C. G. Fuller was born in Ohio and moved to Barnwell, South Carolina in the 1930's. Owning only a dump truck, Mr. Fuller entered the road construction business, by which he became very successful. By the time Mr. Fuller died in 1972 he had amassed considerable wealth.

Having no children of his own to inherit his fortune, Mr. Fuller created the C. G. Fuller Foundation. One of the purposes of the Foundation is to provide scholarships for worthy South Carolina students.

Mr. Fuller had not been able to attend college, yet he recognized the value of a college education. He therefore wanted to help other young people attend college, who would not be able to without assistance.

The criteria for receiving a scholarship are: a high school senior, a South Carolina resident, attendance at a South Carolina college or university, Adjusted Gross Income of \$60,000 or less, a minimum score of 1100 on SAT or a minimum score of 24 on ACT. The scholarship is \$1,250.00 per semester. It is automatically renewed for 4 years provided a cumulative 3.0 GPA is maintained.

The Foundation has also made substantial grants to Carolina Children's Home, Epworth Children's Home, Barnwell County Hospital, Barnwell County Library, Barnwell County Museum & Historical Board, Richland County Public Library and numerous other community grants.

Individual trustees of the Foundation are Clinton C. Lemon (son of Calhoun Lemon), Barnwell, South Carolina and Victor B. John, III (son of Victor B. John, Jr.) Columbia, South Carolina. Calhoun Lemon and Victor B. John, Jr. were business associates of Mr. Fuller. The corporate trustee is Bank of America, N. A., represented by Cindy Burton, Senior Vice President.
