

## Application for Nontraditional Credit for Certified Police Officers

Instructions: Students seeking nontraditional credit must meet the following criteria:

- Active certification as a Class One Police Officer by the South Carolina Criminal Justice Academy (In Good Standing)
- Or retired (In Good Standing)
- Or another approved academy in the United States (State or Federal)

The applicant must understand that it is his/her responsibility to furnish all required documentation to the Charleston Southern Registrar's Office including this form and a certified transcript from the South Carolina Criminal Justice Academy (SCCJA) indicating successful completion of the Basic Law Enforcement Training or another approved academy in the United States (State or Federal).

Upon receipt and verification of all documentation, the Registrar's Office shall award Nontraditional credit as follows:

- Undergraduate: 3 hours for CRIM 362 Criminal Procedure and 3 hours for CRIM 374 Police Practices.
- Graduate: 3 hours for CRIM 655 Advanced Law Enforcement
