Purpose: To establish a policy for the acceptance of home-schooled student applicants.

Home-schooled students applying for admission to CSU must meet the following requirements:

- a. A transcript must be submitted, indicating grades and the curriculum employed,
- b. the student must have satisfied relevant educational requirements for the state in which the student was a resident, and
- c. the student must meet the same SAT (or ACT) and other admissions requirements as other incoming high school students.
