ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Admission requirements are subject to change. All transfer credit awards are at the discretion of the CSU Registrar.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Student of record at CSU at time of application.
- Submission of College of Nursing ABSN application.
- Minimum 3.0 GPA on 4.0 scale in Pre-Nursing prerequisite courses.
- Minimum 3.0 GPA on 4.0 scale in combined Pre-Nursing + Liberal Arts Core prerequisite courses.
- "C" or better in all prerequisite courses.
- Completion of required Math and Science prerequisites within 5 years of the application date. If you hold an Associate or Bachelor of Science degree, Math and Science courses must have been completed within the last 10 years.

APPLICATION DEADLINES:

Applications open on August 1, the year prior to the Cohort start date. Applications close on March 1 in the year of the Cohort start date.

DISCLAIMER: Pre-Nursing & LAC courses may have their own prerequisite requirements.

Students should review the CSU course catalog when planning schedules.

ADMISSION PROCESS:

The Accelerated BSN track has a rolling admission process, and the College of Nursing Admission & Progression Committee meets regularly to review applications. Official transcripts must be on file for consideration to the BSN program.

IMPORTANT: If a student previously took nursing courses at another institution, the CSU College of Nursing requires written confirmation that the student left in good standing and is eligible to return. This letter must be on official program letterhead, written by the current Dean or Undergraduate Program Director, and sent directly to Dr. Donna Timko, Pre-Nursing Coordinator, at dtimko@csuniv.edu.

The BSN program at CSU is a competitive-entry program, and admission to the university does not guarantee admission to the nursing program.

The 18-month-long accelerated Bachelor of Science in Nursing (ABSN) is designed for those with a minimum of 58 credit hours of previous college credit *or* an earned associate or bachelor's degree in another field. This concentrated program will prepare you to meet the healthcare needs of a diverse society. Classes will be offered asynchronously online with required on-campus days. Labs will be held on CSU's campus on weekday evenings and clinical rotations will be in Charleston area hospitals on Friday, Saturday, and/or Sunday.

The Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree program has full approval of the South Carolina Board of Nursing and is accredited by the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing. Graduates are eligible to take the National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurse practice (NCLEX-RN).
