ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Admission requirements are subject to change.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Student of record at CSU at time of application.
- Minimum 2.90 GPA on 4.0 scale in Pre-Nursing prerequisite courses.
- "C" or better in all Pre-Nursing prerequisite courses.
- Completion of the required nursing admission exam, at the student's expense.
- Submission of College of Nursing application for the intended semester of admission.
- Completion of required Math and Science prerequisites within 5 years of the application date. If you hold a Bachelor of Science degree, Math and Science courses must have been completed within the last 10 years.

Course Retake Policy:

Students are allowed a total of two retakes in the Pre-Nursing prerequisite courses to maintain eligibility for admission.
