

SCHOLARSHIPS & GRANTS Scholarships are awarded to students based on academic merit or special talent. Grants are administered

based on financial need. There is no repayment necessary for scholarships and grants.

STUDENT LOANS

Designed specifically for educational purposes, these low-interest loans are set up for repayment which typically begins after graduation.

Applying for Aid...as **Simple** as 1-2-3-4



1. Apply to CSU at charlestonsouthern.edu/apply.

All full-time students accepted for admission are automatically considered for merit-based scholarships.



2. Submit your financial aid application at fafsa.gov from OCTOBER 1 until JUNE 30. The

Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is the standard application required for all colleges and universities. CSU's school code is 003419.



3. Fill out the release form located in your MyCSU account. All students are required to complete the Student Information Release Authorization (FERPA). This gives you access to your records and grants CSU permission to discuss educational records with your parents, spouse and employers.



4. Complete your financial aid file by **June 30.** Once you have finalized the FAFSA and have been accepted to CSU, you can view your up-to-date financial aid information, missing documents, special messages and more by accessing Financial Aid LIVE through your MyCSU account. You can also download the

mobile app mystudentaid.

GRANTS, WORK-STUDY & LOANS

GRANTS

FEDERAL PELL GRANT

The Federal Pell Grant is available to undergraduates who demonstrate financial need. The amount of aid you can receive depends on your need, the cost of attendance, expected family contribution and more.

FEDERAL SUPPLEMENTAL EDUCATIONAL **OPPORTUNITY GRANTS (SEOG)**

The SEOG Program offers additional grants up to \$1,000 for undergraduate students with exceptional financial need.

WORK-STUDY

The Federal Work-Study Program allows students to work 10-14 hours weekly and apply earnings toward tuition and room/ board charges. Working on campus provides flexibility, convenience and camaraderie with other students.

CSU students enjoy work-study opportunities like:

LOANS

FEDERAL DIRECT LOANS

Direct Subsidized Loans (need-based) and Direct Unsubsidized Loans (not need-based) are federally regulated low-interest loan programs provided by the school. The type of loan you receive is based on your federal financial need.







FEDERAL DIRECT PLUS LOAN

The Parent PLUS Loan enables parents of dependent students to borrow for their students' education, based on credit approval.

PRIVATE LOANS

Many financial institutions offer private student loans to supplement federal programs. A credit-worthy cosigner may be required by the lender. Interest rates and borrower benefits will vary depending on the individual's or cosigner's credit history.
