1. Apply online at charlestonsouthern.edu/international.
2. Send official transcripts from all high schools or colleges attended.
3. Submit English proficiency test results from one of the following:
 - TOEFL minimum 71
 - IELTS minimum 6.0
 - PTE Academic minimum 51
 - iTEP minimum 3.7
 - SAT or ACT
4. Supply a passport copy and applicable visa documents.
