STUDENT CLASSIFICATION YEAR IN SCHOOL	R-17	1 of 1	June 29, 1984

Purpose: To identify the "Year in School" Classification of students.

A student's "Year in School" Classification is determined by the cumulative (total) credit hours earned by a student. The undergraduate classifications are as follows:

CLASSIFICATIONS	CUMULATIVE HOURS
Freshman	Up to 29
Sophomore	30 to 59
Junior	60 to 89
Senior	90 or more

SPECIAL STUDENTS - A special student is one who is not a candidate for a degree.

GRADUATE STUDENTS - A graduate student is one who has earned a Bachelor's Degree and has enrolled in a graduate level course offered by the University. **DOCTORAL STUDENTS** are graduate students accepted to university doctorate programs.
