Four-year Junior Graduation Rate	The basis (denominator) for the calculation is all students in the BBA Program major who became juniors (60 to 90 credit hours) during the 2019-20 school year. The number of students who graduated by Spring 2024 is the four-year measure (numerator).	
Five-year Masters Graduation Rate	The basis (denominator) for the calculation is the number of students in the MBA Program entering the summer, fall and spring semester cohorts of the 2019-20 school-year. The number of students who graduated by Spring of 2024 is the measure (numerator).
